

And drink the water of life.



God, What a Faith-Filled Mystery


God, what a faith-filled mystery, That your own Child once died! In Christ is true humanity — your love — personified.

It is right to give God



Lord's Prayer


Our Father in heaven, hallowed be your name. Your kingdom come, your will be done, on earth as in heaven. Give us today our daily bread.
